

**GRASS LAKE CHARTER TOWNSHIP  
APPROVED WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES  
March 26, 2019**

**Board Members Present by Roll Call:** Stormont, Loveland, Bray, Lester and Zenz. Absent Brennan & Butterfield.

**Also Present:** Zoning Administrator Lammers, Park Manager Howe, Fire Chief Jones and Bob Hamel.

**Meeting** called to order by Supervisor Stormont at 8:03 am in the Township Conference Room.

**Park Lawn Service** – Received quote from All Green Landscaping (Don Holden). Stormont and Zenz spoke to him and to Nate Ball. Ball glad to give up one cemetery (West) he would do the East Cemetery and Fishville Road. Holden quoted a price of \$110.00 for mowing of Township Hall and Fire Department and \$450.00 for Sports-n-Trails Park, this would be for per occurrence. Bray not totally happy with way grass at soccer field was mowed last year. Stormont will be talking to the Village.

**Enforcement Officer Job Posting** - Steve Bisard is checking into the person doing enforcement in Springport Village/Township. Suggested adding qualifications and pay to posting description that Stormont has prepared.

**Business Expo** - will review next year if changes have been made before a decision made to participate.

**LDFA Board Appointment** – Stormont presented the list of names currently on the board. There is a minimum of 11 and maximum of 13. The district is established and the board just needs to be re-activated in order for the board to come up with a development plan. Lester would like to be added to the board if there is an opening.

**Township Office Defibrillator purchase** – There is already one in the Township Hall, Jones will look into purchasing a cabinet for it and getting it installed.

**Summer Youth League – update** – Howe presented highlights from the Recreation Board Meeting on March 20, 2019. Bray stated that the field usage agreements are still being worked on. The Board in general feels good improvements are taking place and it will take some time for everything to be worked out.

**Fixing Michigan's Road Mess Summit** – Stormont handed out information about the summit.

**American 1 Mobile Office** – Lammers was asked about a temporary use permit for use at Coppernoll's Hardware Parking Lot and during Farmer's Market Night. It does fit into the parameters of temporary

use just would need a site plan drawing showing where the mobile unit would be sitting. It can be for 6 months and would need the Township Board's approval.
