Police Power Ordinance Adoption - Junk Vehicle - An amendment has been prepared for the board to review. Stormont asked the board to review and hopefully be able to introduce the amendment at the October Board Meeting.

Cedar Knoll Property Update - September 27, 2018 at noon has been scheduled for the closing of the Cedar Knoll Property at American Title in Jackson. Balance of sale \$140,000.00. Stormont and Loveland will attend.

Charitable Gaming Resolution - Still waiting to hear back from Mr Murphy with information that the Township requested.

Brennan arrived at this time.

Sports & Trails Park usage agreements - A representative from each group wanting to use the park are to be at the October Recreation Board Meeting. Ryan Davis from the Renegade's was present to introduce himself and give information about his league.

DEQ Meeting Update - DEQ violation - the dirt has been removed from low land area and placed on the area designated as not lowlands by the DEQ. They have given a green light for the basketball area, should get started with placement of one court in the next few weeks. The DEQ has not stated if any new permits need to be obtained, currently there are NO violations. Stormont has applied for grants through the Wellness Foundation for handicap picnic tables, cement and hip shade at the park and a hip shade at the Township Office.

Zoning Enforcement- The Township is experiencing a lot more ordinance enforcement request than in the past. Lammers would like to find someone to take over this part of the zoning.

Township New Office Committee - Bray and Lester are representatives from the Township, a meeting needs to get scheduled.
