Holiday Campground – Region 2 response – Jackson County Planning Commission has recommended approval of the rezoning with comments after receiving the information from the Grass Lake Charter Township Planning Commission. This would bring the campground into conforming with a change from LI to R-2. Final adoption would be at the June 13, 2017 regular board meeting.

Site Plan Review Fee language – The current fee schedule needs to be looked at with revisions made if necessary. Lesinski and Zenz have not worked on this but will have something ready for the June 13 board meeting.

RFP – Basketball Courts – Lester had offered to work on this, and he has a preliminary almost done but has some questions. Stormont and Lester will go to the site after work session so the proposal will be ready for the June 13th meeting.

Cedar Knoll Listing – The current listing expires on June 27, 2017. Stormont would like the board to be thinking of what to do after this date. Ben Latocki ~~Bray~~ and DeBoe have had some people contact them about possible interest in the property. Fritz Advertising also had a possible client interested in purchasing part of the property to put up a bill board sign.

Software Update – Zenz reported that the training starts next Tuesday and is scheduled to last two and half weeks.

Gator at Park – Hart had inquired about who has keys, Stormont will take care of this. The utility trailer is still in need of fixing, Hart is not able to do it. John Walters name was given as a contact to check with and also Fitzgibbons as that is where the trailer came from, Lester will contact them to come and look at it.
