

APPROVED WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board held a work session on Tuesday, February 26, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. at the Township Hall. Board members Stormont, Clark, Bray and Lesinski present. Also present: Assessor Diane DeBoe. Board Members Harshbarger and Zenz Absent. Loveland arrived at 9:30 a.m.

Items discussed were the Ganton Sewer Connections. Setting up a joint meeting with the Village of Grass Lake Council to discuss further the Ganton Sewer Connections.

An application has been received from MSW (Marion Meadows) for a rezoning request. They wish to have the zoning changed from R-2 Single Family Residential to R-3 Multipy Family Residential. The Planning Commission will be holding a public hearing on March 20th.

Supervisor Stormont is preparing a “power point” to have for the March 15th and 16th Chamber of Commerce Expo to be held at the Grass Lake High School.

Stormont asked that the board work on the area to be designated as “LDFA” and be prepared to make a decision at the next regular scheduled board meeting.

Stormont would also like to start an Economic Development Group here, consisting of a representative from the Village, Township, Downtown Development Authority and the Grass Lake Community Schools.

The IRS has set a rate for Business Miles for 2008 at 50.5 cents per mile.

Assessor Diane DeBoe gave us a “Looking Ahead” letter in regard to all the work that is needed to be done in her department. She basically is wanting additional help. The board ask that she give some hours that would be needed to complete some of the items.

The next work session will be held on Tuesday, March 25th at 8:30 a.m. at the Township Hall.
