

APPROVED WORK SESSION MINUTES

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board work session was called to order on Tuesday, January 27th, 2009 at 9: 30 a.m. Board members Stormont, Clark, Loveland, Lesinski present. Absent: Adams, Bray, Hart. Also present Assessor DeBoe

Stormont handed out a resolution that has to be passed in order to hold the March Board of Review a different day of the week than required by law.

Clark stated that the Insurance claim regarding the water damage at the Fire Station has been completed and payment is being processed.

Stormont stated that with the Dangerous Building Ordinance we can post and publish on the web site and do not have to publish complete ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation.

Representative Mike Simpson has inquired as to whether it would be okay to use our facilities to hold meetings on the first Friday of every month from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. starting in February.

Stormont has received notice from Steve Hanson from Professional Lake Management and would like us to issue a check so that he may go ahead and purchase the permits from the DEQ.

Clark mentioned that she felt that we should have a monthly Invoice approval of any bills that come for payment for the Sports and Trails – Community Park. Stormont, Doug Moeckel and Heather Brown attended a meeting with the Jackson County Parks Commission and have been able to get 4 batting cages that have to be taken down and removed by May 1st. Lesinski asked if we could get the Lester Bros. bill paid.

Loveland spoke in regard to the Assessor not being in the office as to the hours that she has stated she would be here. She has it posted as being here 12 hrs. a week and he asks that she be here the times she has posted.
