

APPROVED WORK SESSION MINUTES

September 24, 2013

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board met on Tuesday, September 24, 2013 at 8:30 for their monthly work session. Board Members present: Stormont, Loveland, Lesinski, Hart and Brennan. Absent: Adams. Also present: Deputy Clerk Zenz, Assessor DeBoe and Zoning Administrator Lammers.

The following items were discussed:

Loveland would like to have Anna Loveland be hired as Temporary Office Assistant to be able to help in the office during the absence of Judy Parzych.

Clerk Position – due to the passing of Clerk Marjorie Clark discussion was held on appointment of the new clerk.

Tennis Court Nets – Steve Moyer will give a recommendation for the nets and will take charge of putting the nets up and down for the season.

Ida Watson – Our insurance company stated no compensation, but Attorney Fahey has reviewed and sent letter back to the insurance company so hopefully there will be some compensation for the expense incurred.

Mr. Lemieux on Clear Lake Road is currently converting a home into a Deli/Ice Cream Establishment along with the catering business run from the home. He is inquiring about a wine and beer license – this is a permitted use in a General Commercial Zone. He will be working with the State for acquiring this license.

Bid received from Bobby Stoker for improvements at the Northwest ball field at the Township Park for \$2,975.00 and \$2,450.00 for the T-ball Diamond.

Willis Road Fence – will need 827 feet of fence and post along with the cement. Received a check from the liability insurance for \$6,265.00 for the fence that was stolen.

Prepare bid package for cleaning of Township Office and Hall – Loveland and DeBoe will do a walk thru of the necessary needs inside and outside and then prepare the package.

IT Right will be installing the new server October 11 and 15.

A new label has been made for Drop Box.

Leoni Sewer – update on what has been happening.

Whistlestop Shed – new doors have been installed, but need to be painted. Hart will look into the original bid to see if painting was part of it.
