

Approved Work Session

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board met on Tuesday, July 31, 2012 at 8:35 a.m. for a Work Session at the Township Conference Room. Board Members; Stormont, Clark, Loveland, Bray and Lesinski present. Absent: Adams, Jr. and Hart. Also present was Fire Chief Greg Jones.

The purpose of this Work Session was to list the items of which we feel need to be addressed in maintenance of the Township Building and Grounds.

- Thermo Payne Windows in main office area
- Repair Front Door (facing lake)
- Light over front door (facing lake)
- Paint Exterior of Building
- Fill Dirt – Ball Fields
- Berm on East Side of Parking Lot
- Replace Furnace and Air Conditioners in Main offices
- Seawall – shoreline
- Bathrooms – Made more attractive
- New Bumpers for Parking Lot
- Vault room

After discussion of above items listed, it was the decision of the board to get quotes for replacing the furnace and air conditioners in main office and for replacement of windows in the main office.

Trustee Lesinski asked what the board would think in regard to placing a permanent sign at the Community Park which would list the names of those who had made donations. Several ideas were discussed with no final decisions.

Trustee Bray would like to have the fireworks brought back to Grass Lake Township 4th of July celebration. He would like to know if the Township would be interested in donating and if so he is willing to work with other organizations and the Village to see if they would be interested in contributing.

Supervisor Stormont then presented a quote and information from Tractor Supply Company for the purchase of a 40 gallon sprayer that would be pulled behind the lawn mower for killing the weeds along the trails, ball fields or where ever needed. It was the consensus of the board members present that it was under \$ 2500.00 and if it was needed right away, to go ahead and make the purchase.
