

APPROVED WORK SESSION

The Grass Lake Charter Township Board met on Tuesday, October 26, 2010 at the Township Hall at 8:30 a.m. for the monthly work session. Board members Stormont, Clark, Loveland, Lesinski, Bray and Hart present. Absent: Adams, Jr.

Supervisor gave an update regarding the Unison Cell Tower proposal. He is still working with the DNR regarding the cell tower in regard to the grant application. He stated that the Michigan Center Schools have approximately 600 feet of fence that is like the fence that we have at the Community Park and for which they will sell it to us for \$ 300.00. We would still have to buy cement and post in order to do the installation of the fence. The field usage agreements for Baseball and Soccer should be turned in at our November meeting. We will plan to meet at 7:00 p.m. with their representatives.

The Anti-Noise Ordinance needs to have the wording changed to state Animal Control, Stormont will make the changes and bring it back to the board.

Discussion was held in regard to the removal of the leaves in the cemeteries. Loveland stated that his son and two of his friends who are attending Jackson Community College would be willing to get as much done as weather permits. We are also talking with Dick Clark to see what the cost would be for him and his partner to pick up the leaves and the boys would have to rake them just to the driveways.
