**APPROVED WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES**  
**June 22, 2021**

**Board Members Present by Roll Call:** Bednarski-Lynch, Loveland, Zenz, Lesinski, Golding and Brennan. Absent: Bray. Others in attendance: Diane DeBoe.

**Meeting** called to order by Supervisor Lesinski at 8:00 am. at the Township Meeting Room.

**Adoption of Agenda** – Zenz asked to add MTA Online Learning as #5 and Bednarski-Lynch asked to add Public Funds as #6. Motion by Brennan to approve agenda with additions, supported by Bednarski-Lynch. Motion Carried.

**Website information** – Schumacher Group had phone conversation with Lesinski last week, they are working with IT Right in the web development side. Cost would be around \$2,500.00 for initial set-up and then a yearly cost after that. Comstock and Lima Township currently use them, so we need to take a look at their sites.

**Planning Commission Surveys** – Surveys will soon be available to the public, which is part of the 5 year Master Plan. They will be available on our website, tax bills, facebook within the next couple of weeks.

**Fisher Update** - Preliminary Site Plan was turned in do the Planning Commission. There are some things missing on it, will be working with Mr Fisher towards the final site plan. The Board may need to get involved in the decision process. The next Planning Commission meeting is July 22.

**Special Assessment District** – Lesinski has been working with a group of Grass Lake property lake owners, DeBoe and Zenz. He has received a quote from PLM for the cost of treatment for the next 5 years. A couple of scenarios have been put together, so the group can help decide which direction they want to go in, the next step is to circulate petitions for majority approval.

**MTA Online Learning** – The Board feels this would be very beneficial and would like to utilize the Premium Pass.

**Public Funds** – This is looking like the funds can be used almost anywhere. Lesinski is following this carefully to make sure that we do not miss any deadlines. Use at park or Township Hall. This will be visit as needed.
