

GRASS LAKE CHARTER TOWNSHIP

April 25, 2022

Work Session called to order by Supervisor Lesinski at 8:00 a.m. at the Township Conference Room.

Board Members Present by Roll Call: Golding, Lesinski, Loveland, Zenz and Bray. Absent: Bednarski-Lynch and Brennan.

Also Present: Fire Chief Jones and Village Manager Sabrina Edgar

Bednarski-Lynch and Loveland Brennan arrived at 8:05 am.

Golding moved to accept the agenda. Supported by Bray. Motion Carried.

Park Soccer Wall – Gus Vitale an Eagle Scout will be putting up a “soccer wall” to earn his eagle badge. He will be working with Caleb Allen head of the AYSO. Only request is that the wall is kept in good repair and weed whip around so easier for the mowing.

Meeting with Dr. Kyser – Lesinski will be meeting today with him to let him know that the second officer being put on by the Township should not be so the school does not have an officer on staff. The availability of our office on duty might not being school hours.

Signs – Lesinski has received 2 quotes for the sign at the Sports-n-Trails, he has filed an insurance claim for the repairs. We would like to make a decision on which quote, Chris Osinski or Fritz Signs. Lesinski will be contacting each again for some clarification.

Candidate for Trustee – Frank Lamborghini has filed the paper work on time to have his name on the August ballot. No other person filed.

County Budgets – Lesinski will be sending letters to Shotwell and Walz to provide us with the County budget. May need to FOIA to get this information. Want to see where all their money is going. The office is getting a lot of road complaints and want to know why no attention is being given to the roads.

Zoning issues – have received some formal complaints, so some letters will be going out to people with blight, junk cars/vehicles and dangerous buildings. Lesinski and Lammers will be working on this.

ARPA Funds – 1st report will be submitted this week.

Sewer and Water Discussion – Edgar spoke of the Water Street Lift Station issue – it is broken and the cost to repair it and the main reason for failure, hoping some insurance money will help in the repairs. Much discussion on the direction the water and sewer are going, the board may have to be making a lot of decisions in the near future. We will continue to have dialog with the Village to keep up to date with on going issues.
